

EUCCHARISTIC MINISTER * JOB DESCRIPTION

The Ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are bishops, priests, and deacons who, by their ordination, have the responsibility of providing communion to the faithful. Lay people, who serve as Eucharistic Ministers, are "extraordinary" or "outside the ordinary" ministers. Their primary task is to assist with the smooth distribution of Holy Communion at Mass. They may also bring the Blessed Sacrament to those who are sick or homebound. Training will be provided.

- A love for the Catholic Church
- An understanding of the teachings of the Catholic Church
- Regular Mass attendance on Sunday/Holy Days
- Regular participation in the Sacraments
- A dignified demeanor
