## HOLY COMMUNION...

The Last Words & Thoughts...  
I promise!

If you have difficulty walking, the front pews of the church are reserved for you. The Priest, Deacon and all Eucharist Ministers know to bring the communion to you so that you do not have to walk up the aisle. This should make it easier for you and for the ministers. They look for you in these pews to serve you. Also, you will be offered the cup. If you do not want to receive from the cup, a simple shake of the head, no, will alert that minister.

If you are taking Holy Communion to someone who is sick or unable to come to church, you must take the Communion to them using a pyx. These are special containers for carrying the consecrated host. They are available for you to borrow in the sacristy. Make sure you see either Deacon John or Father Ray BEFORE Mass to borrow one. After you have received Communion, present the open pyx to the Minister. They will put one host in it for you. Let them know if you are taking Communion to more than one person and need more hosts. Close the pyx and treat it and its contents with respect. Please do not ask for the Holy Communion to be put on a napkin, hanky, etc. After you are through using the pyx, please return it to either Father or Deacon. If you want, you can buy a pyx from a religious store or even online.

If you ever have any questions about Holy Communion, Father Ray and Deacon John are always willing to clarify any questions you may have. They usually stay after Mass and you can talk to them then or give them a call. There are no bad or silly questions. Always feel free to talk about your faith to them!
