## HOLY COMMUNION HOW

**HOW** \*\*And now for the conclusion. . .  
 Third, and now you are standing before the Eucharist Minister. Remember there are two ways of receiving: on the tongue or in the hand. Both are correct and allowed — neither is better or worse. When you are standing in front of the Eucharistic Minister (either priest, deacon or lay minister), make a slight bow. Please don't bow when you are two or three people away from receiving. The purpose of the bow is to give homage and reverence **TO JESUS!** So therefore, do it when you are right in front of **HIM!** The minister will say: "The Body of Christ". Respond with enthusiasm: **AMEN!** Remember that you are saying that you believe you are truly receiving the Body of Christ when you say Amen!

If you are receiving on the tongue, open your mouth and offer your tongue for the Minister to place the host on it. Proceed either to the Minister with the cup or to your pew.

If you are receiving in the hand—please be aware that the Eucharistic Minister is good—but not a mind reader! Therefore, please present your hands with one on top of the other—NOT side by side.

Think of a table, waiting to receive the food! Raise your hands up to receive—the minister will place the host in your hands! Step aside, consume the host by picking it up with your other hand and putting it in your mouth. (Do not lick it off your hand. If you are carrying a child or using a cane, you might consider receiving on the tongue so you don't fumble trying to get the host to your mouth.) You are to consume the host IMMEDIATELY – do not carry it back to your pew. Proceed to the Minister of the Cup or to your pew. Again, please do not stop to greet people on your way back to your pew. They have also just received Jesus and are saying a prayer of Thanksgiving.

\*\*In these last two articles, these are *my* thoughts and views on receiving Holy Communion. It may be that I was taught by the Bernardine Sisters many years ago and those methods, thoughts and instructions have remained with me all my life. It may have been an event that happened when I made my First Communion (maybe I can share that story in another column). Or maybe – and this is probably the most important reason – **I believe that I am going to receive Jesus Christ and this is the most precious gift I can EVER receive** and I'm very passionate about it. I will always want to treat it with the greatest respect. And I can only do that if I approach the altar with hands folded, eyes straight ahead, and my thoughts only on Jesus! Now if someone can help me down off my soapbox, I'd appreciate it!
