ARE YOU A CHECKER OR DOER?

Which one are you in regards to your faith? This Lent, did you make a list of things you want to do and one by one, you are “checking” them off your list of things to do? Or are you actually DOING the things on your list? Let me explain. Recently, Fr. Ray urged us to do something special for Lent in regards to our faith. Some of his suggestions were to read the bible, pray the rosary, do charitable works and other things. So did we run home and make a list—on paper or just in our mind of the things that you planned to do this Lenten season? Are we “checking” them off as we do them? Did you dust off the bible and started reading any place that it opened? CHECK! Did you find your rosary in a pocket, purse, or tucked in a drawer, pull it out and pray a decade or two? CHECK! Did you buy a couple of extra canned goods and brought them up to the Food Bank basket at church? CHECK! Or did you actually read a bible passage and then spend some extra time meditating or thinking about what you just read? Did you try to understand it better by reading the notes at the bottom of the page of the bible? DOING IT! Did you pray that decade of the rosary and pause after each Hail Mary and think about someone who might need your prayers and tell God that you are specifically offering these prayers for that intention? DOING IT! Did you go grocery shopping, buy something for yourself and instead donated it to the Food Bank and therefore did without this week when you ate a meal? DOING IT! What we do is more than making sure that we “check off” everything on our list, rather, think about what you are doing and offering up that “doing”.

Lent has just started — we have 5 more weeks of “checking” or “doing” What will your Lenten Season be like this year? And as Fr. Ray has said many times — it’s never too late to start. And if you don’t quite make it one day, you just start over again tomorrow. God is so generous and gives us another chance every day. Use it and grow in your faith! If you need a little help for your DO IT program: pick up the Little Black Book—there are a few left for you to take one home and start reading; find your rosary and say a few extra prayers this week; give up a candy bar or cookie and make a donation to the food bank; and if nothing else, just spend some quiet time, alone, and listen to Jesus talk to you! You’d be surprise what He wants to talk about with you!
