ONE, TEN, A THOUSAND. . . How many saints can be numbered in the Catholic Church? The question is almost impossible to answer. And for a variety of reasons. One reason is the record keeping of the church. In the early days of the church, people were elevated to sainthood by popular demand of the communities or regions. So those records may not be accurate. Then there are those saints that are based on legends, such as St. Christopher, St. Valentine and others. Then there is the group of saints that had a local following. Such as St. Guinefort from rural France—he was venerated as the protector of infants after he saved his master’s baby from a snakebite. St. Guinefort was a dog. The church was troubled by these types of legends and changed the way a person was named a saint. By the Middle Ages, the process of sainthood was introduced. This process was changed in 1969 by Pope Paul VI when he created the Congregations for the Causes of Saints. And again in 1983, revisions to the canonization process was put in place. With that revision, Pope John Paul 11 canonized more saints that all the popes from the previous 500 year combined!

The answer to our question can be anything from 800 to 10,000! However, although Aunt Peggy may not have been canonized by the Catholic Church as a Saint, she may be a saint because of the simple definition of a saint in Catholicism: any human who is in Heaven! So while I cannot say the exact name of people who have been elevated to sainthood by the church, I do believe that if we live a holy life here on earth, we will become a saint when we reach Heaven! Next week. . .how many American Saints are there?

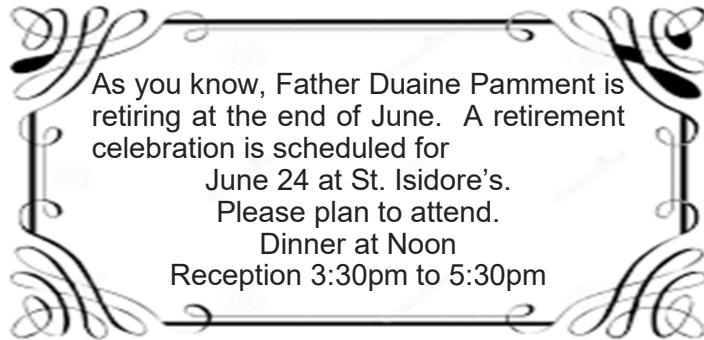
