THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD! Let's take a break from our exploration of US saints to look at the feast day that we are celebrating today, the Ascension of the Lord. I am always looking for another explanation for some of the mysteries of our faith. Sometimes, when I find one, I finally get one of those "aha moments!" The following article was one of those moments for me. It helped me understand this feast a little better and in a different way. I hope it does the same for you. **

"In the glorious mysteries of the rosary, the mystery of the Ascension of the Lord is intended to help us reflect on hope. For most of us the virtue of hope is something quite elusive. I hope things turn out right and I hope it rains — or doesn't. These are things I would like to happen. And there are people who are hopeful, which generally means they are optimistic or have a sunny disposition.

What does the hope mean that is connected with the Ascension of the Lord which we celebrate today? We often think of hope in relation to something we do not yet have or something that has not yet occurred. But our hope as Christians is rooted in the reality that Jesus Christ is with us always and that He sends His Holy Spirit to be with us. His Ascension may be seen as a departure, but in truth it marks a different way of being present. Our Pope Emeritus, Benedict XVI, wrote the following: "In Christ ascended into Heaven, the human being has entered into intimacy with God in a new and unheard of way; man henceforth finds room in God forever. 'Heaven': this word Heaven does not indicate a place above the stars but something far more daring and sublime: it indicates Christ himself, the divine Person who welcomes humanity fully and forever, the One in whom God and man are inseparably united forever. . . We draw close to Heaven, indeed, we enter Heaven to the extent that we draw close to Jesus and enter into communion with him."

This is Christian hope: the knowledge that no matter what happens, what we want, what we wish for, Jesus Christ is with us, now and forever!"

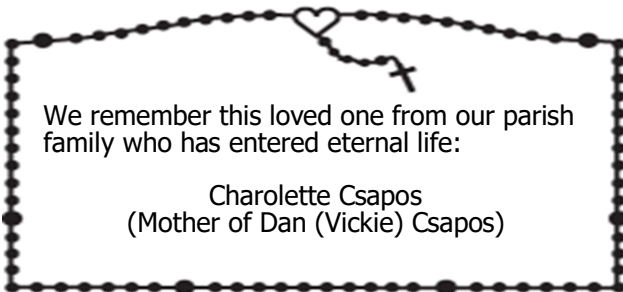
