WHO TOUCHED ME?

The image of hands, meaning to help, to extend oneself to another, is evident in all the readings today. The Book of Wisdom tells us that the hand of God “fashioned all things that they might have being.” It goes on to say that humanity is destined for life and for immortality. Although the passage from 2 Corinthians does not use the word hands, it implies that when a community perceived a need in another community, they should open their hearts and lend a helping hand, as indeed they did. Finally, the Gospel is all about hands touching, healing, helping and giving life. The mere furtive reaching out of the hand of the woman with the menstrual problem to touch Jesus’ clothes results in her being healed, and when Jesus takes the hand of the dead girl into his hands, she comes to life again. In all this what we perceive is that the divine action, whether done directly by Jesus or God, or intermediately through the likes of you and me, is always directed to the end of giving life, healing, restoring one to full participation in the family or community

Interestingly, we often receive back as much if not more when we give, when we reach out and lend a helping hand. Or, putting it another way, though I take the initiative in reaching out and lending a hand, Christian touch, like all touch, is not one-sided: it is an exchange. Whether it is my hand or my heart that reaches out to another, I not only give life, I get life. It is a great experience to see budding on another’s face that wondering, wondrous question: “Who touch me?” and to realize it was not so much you as Christ within you. More thrilling still, when you reach out that way, it is often you who are surprised by joy, you who ask in wonderment: “Who touch me?”
