## HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION

In the Catholic Church, here in the U.S.A., we celebrate 6 days that are designated as “Holy Days of Obligation”\* in addition to all Sundays. This week Wednesday, we celebrate one of those Holy Days — **The Assumption of Mary**. Below are a few facts about this day and hopefully you will understand why you should attend Mass

on this day.

**WHY ASSUMED vs ASCENDED.** . . We say that Jesus Ascended into heaven and Mary was Assumed. What is the difference? We say Jesus ASCENDED into heaven because the definition of ascension is to rise up under one’s own power. Assumed means something is done to someone or something. Jesus, because he is the Second Person of Trinity, had no need of assistance into Heaven, whereas Mary did not have this power.

**WHY DO WE BELIEVE** Mary was assumed into heaven? One of the things that we all believe as Catholics about Mary is that she was chosen by God to bear His son. And therefore, because of this belief, it is easy for us to believe that Mary’s body should not suffer corruption in a grave. The reward for the role she played in the life of Jesus should be higher than the rest of us, so the Assumption of her body into heaven is that reward, as well as life everlasting with her Son, our Savior. The Feast of the Assumption is a source of great hope for us—it points the way for all followers of Christ to imitate Mary in her fidelity and obedience to God’s will. Where Mary is now, we hope to eventually be!

**WHEN** do we celebrate this feast? The belief in Mary’s bodily assumption is universal in Eastern and Western Catholic Churches of today. Both Churches celebrate the feast on August 15th. However, there are some differences between the two churches belief. The Feast of the Assumption is a reminder to all of us of the faith and obedience of Mary in saying **“YES”** to God. She and Joseph faithfully raised the young man Jesus so as to prepare him for his ministry. She stood by him throughout his life and death and is receiving a just reward. Let us celebrate together this Wednesday, August 15th at Mass, either 8:30 am or 6:30 pm.

\* In case you are wondering, Holy Days of Obligation vary from country to country. There is only one in Hong Kong, while the Vatican celebrates 10! Each country may celebrate different days that emphasize their patron saints, etc.
