**WORDS, DEFINITIONS, MEANINGS.**

. . . Many words have different meanings for different people and things. One of those words is MISSION. . . .What do you think of when you hear the word “mission”? It can be a military mission, a space mission, a fund raising mission and more. And one of those *more* is a ‘CHURCH’ MISSION. One definition of a church mission is to have someone come to the parish and talk about our faith. Church missions like this do not happen often and not all parishes offer them. There was a mission held at Holy Family a number of years ago. At that time, it was well attended and I do believe that people walked away with a deeper understand of their faith and a renewed purpose to help spread the Good News. You will once again have the opportunity to attend a Church Mission—at St. Cyril’s Church in Bannister. This Mission will start on Sunday, November 4th, 7 pm. There will be a presentation each night, ending on the 7th of November. The speaker at this Mission is Fr. Jack Conley. He comes from St. Vincent Strami Retreat, a Passionist Community at Catholic Theological Union in Chicago.

The theme of the Mission is: **“Rekindling the Fire”**. Each night will explore a different aspect of this theme. The schedule is as follows:

Sunday: **VISION: From Wounds to Wonder**  
 Monday: **PASSION: From Magic to Mystery**  
 Tuesday: **FORGIVENESS: From Hurt to Harmony**  
 Wednesday: **HOPE: From Grumbling to Gratitude**

FR. Conley will also be available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation if anyone desires to receive this sacrament.

Just a few short weeks ago, many people in the dioceses of Lansing came together at the Breslin Center for a presentation of the “Made for Happiness” program. This was a mini- mission. Many attended and the consensus was that they all felt revitalized, energized, and ready to spread the word of God to others. That is the purpose of attending a Mission and hosting one. The attendance at the Made for Happiness program (Mission) was well attended. If you didn’t make it, try to attend at least one night of the Mission that will be presented at St. Cyril’s. It is not required to attend all of the presentations, however, often one presentation leads to the next one.
