PALM SUNDAY. . . As we continue our Lenten journey, here's the last offering for Lent from the book "Practicing Love".

"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" Psalm 22:1 & Mark 15:34

When we hear the whole story of Jesus' passion, this line is so hard. Of course Jesus feels defeated on the cross, perhaps alone and afraid. And these words he says are a quotation from the first line of Psalm 22. The people who were there would have known that Jesus was pointing them to the psalm rather than trying to say that God had abandoned him. The psalm is a lament, a particular kind of prayer where we express frustration and anger to God as an act of faith. It is safe for us to tell God our worst fears, our hardest feelings. God can handle them. And when we cry out to him, we give him permission to enter into them with us and transform them, just like he transforms the cross into eternal life. When Robyn was three, she saw a crucifix, a huge statue of Jesus on the cross, and she got really upset, saying, "We have to do something, Mommy!" And I said we would. We were going to stay with Jesus so he knew he wasn't alone. I said that we would stay at the church as long as she wanted. Lament means we stay with God, not pretending everything is okay, but falling apart when we need to and remembering that God is with us for the worst!

PRAY. . . . *Jesus I give you my heart with my acts of love today.*

PRACTICE LOVE. . . Read all of Psalm 22 together today. Talk about a time when you felt that you were totally alone, that no one understood you, maybe even that God was not close. How did you get through? Who reminded you that you weren't alone?"

Holy Week starts and thus we are ending the Lenten Season and await Easter Morning and Jesus' rising from the grave. What will you do in this final week to be ready?
