## WHY GO TO CHURCH. . . .PART 2

We have started the summer season with the celebration of Memorial Day Week-end. With that, it seems that our children can come up with many reasons why they don't want to go to church. I found the following article on this and would like to share it with you, maybe it will help when faced with the "I don't want to go to church" dilemma from children:

### Making a Child Go to Church

Recently, a mother asked me, "Should I make my son go to church?" I answered, "Yes, definitely." Then I explained: "What do you say when you son decides he does not want to go to school? What did you do when he was little and did not want to take a bath? How did you react when he was sick and did not want his medicine?"

Every right-thinking parent recognizes the importance of these matters, and gives the child no opportunity to decide for himself. Instead, parents explain the importance of going to school, taking a bath, or taking medicine when sick.

So, mom and dad, take time to explain the importance of going to church; then simply say to your son or daughter, "In our family we all go to church and that includes you."

Our children will continue and grow in their faith (hopefully) when they are given a good example. Hopefully, Mass attendance as a family is that good example. Have a safe and happy summer and try to include Week-end Mass attendance a part of that happy summer!
