CRUCIFIX. . . . *I came across several articles of POPE FRANCIS' thoughts on the crucifix. His words made me stop and really think about the crucifix. What are your thoughts about the crucifix? Here are his thoughts. . .*

“ ‘How do I look at the crucifix? Like a work of art, to see if it is beautiful or not beautiful? Or do I look inside, within the wounds of Jesus, to his heart? Do I look at the mystery of God destroyed unto death, like a slave, like a criminal?’

He went on to say that the crucifix is not just something decorative to hang on the wall or wear, ‘it is an important sign of our beliefs and should be truly looked at and prayed before as the source of our salvation. We should turn our gaze to the crucifix as a religious sign to be contemplated and understood.’

The image of Jesus crucified reveals the mystery of the death of the Son of God as the supreme act of love, the source of life and salvation for humanity of all times. In his wounds, we have been healed.

Pope Francis has suggested a beautiful practical devotion for people to make and said :

‘Look at a crucifix and pray one Our Father for each of the wounds of Christ. When we pray the Our Father, we try to enter through the wounds of Jesus [all the way to the] inside. . . Right to his heart. And there we will learn the great wisdom of the mystery of Christ, the great wisdom of the cross.’ ”

Every Catholic home should have a crucifix and we should display it in a place where we can look at it daily. It would be great if every Catholic home more than one crucifix! Do you have at least one crucifix in your home? Try Pope Francis' suggestion of reflection on the crucifix and daily prayer.
