CALENDARS. . . It seems that stuff just seems to sneak up on me, even though I have a calendar hanging in my kitchen, another one on my phone, and again one by my computer! One would think that one of these calendars would make the lightbulb in my head go off and make me aware of what's up next. But as usual, things have a way of sneaking up. Do you realize that Ash Wednesday is just a few weeks away? Are you ready for this Lenten Season? Have you made any plans yet? What acts of charity or penance will you try to include in your Lenten practices this year?

Here's a suggestion for you—we will be offering our virtual **“Walk to Jerusalem”** this year. If you remember, we did this several years ago at Holy Family. This year, we are asking our St. Isidore parishioners to “join” in and “walk” to Ovid and “pick up” all the Holy Family “walkers” and continue on to Jerusalem. We plan on arriving by Easter. We need to “walk” approximately 6,018 miles to Jerusalem! Will we make it? We will if we get participation from both churches. You are asked to sign up at either church. There will be “mileage” sheets for you to keep track of your miles each week. You are asked to turn in these sheets so we can mark our total progress. Then follow along on the map and see our progress! Because this is a “virtual walk”, you can earn miles by actually walking or doing other physical activities. But if you are not able to do the physical “miles”, we are also including “spiritual miles”. Those miles are earned by praying, bible reading and other spiritual activities. The mileage sheets will list all the activities. This was a very successful program in the past and we hope to once again make it to Jerusalem this year by Easter!
