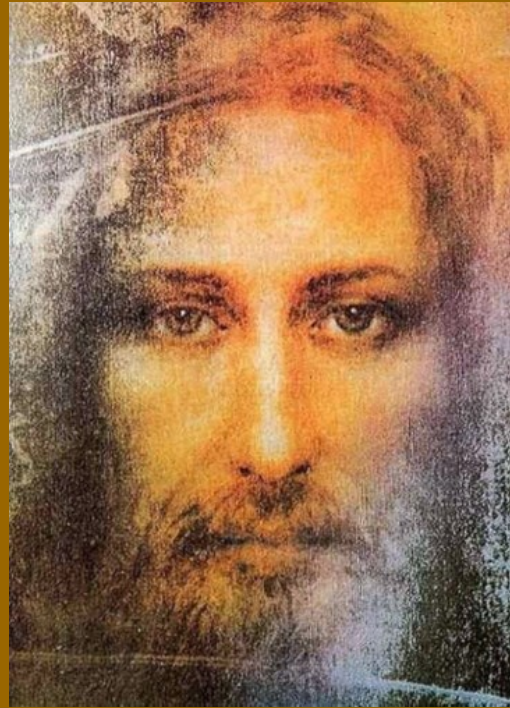

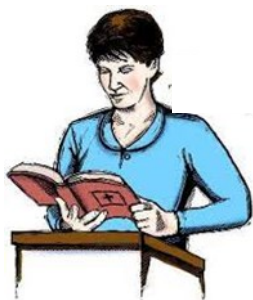

Parish Council Updates

At the last Parish Council meeting we received updates from Fr. Anthony on the work being done around the parish--roofing and sealants (and insurance payments), bathroom and hall improvements, sound system work, water softeners,.... Some work is done, and other things are still in progress, but it all still moving forward. The finance council report revealed no concerns for the foreseeable future despite the amount of work being commissioned in the parish right now.

Other updates included notes on the efforts to get parishioners involved in more of parish life (the Gratitude Corner), plans to update the parish website and plans for Corpus Christi and the parish picnic this summer. The most important piece of that for you is to **SAVE THE DATES**--Corpus Christi will be celebrated after the 11:00 Mass at Holy Family on June 11 and the parish picnic will also be at Holy Family after the 11:00 Mass on August 27. We look forward to seeing everyone at both events! A few other items around the parish include a retreat for our lectors in May, scholarships administered by the K of C (get those applications in!), the return of the K of C yard sale on Sept. 9 and some talk of deep cleaning the kitchen at St. Isidore. Spring is here and we are gearing up for summer events!
