QUILTING QUIPS. . . . The Quilting Ministry started in 2010 and has been self-supporting from its beginning. We have made over 1,000 quilts in all those years plus we have donated money for many years to the local food banks. We do NOT receive any money from the church budget. We are fortunate that many people have donated material, sewing machines, rulers and much more to keep us making quilts! Recently the quilters received a monetary donation in memory of Dale Constine that allowed us to buy a new roll of batting that was needed to make more quilts during the coming weeks! Thank you to Dale's family—he will be remembered with every quilt made.

The weather may have finally warmed up, but the quilters are still busy inside (and if it gets any warmer—we will have the A/C turned on for your comfort!). Recently they volunteered to help the ZCJB Lodge. The Lodge donates their time to make quilts, adult cover ups, fidget quilts and more. They needed some help to tie quilts—and we gladly helped finish some of them. Also, the Quilters received bags of beanie babies and other stuffed animals. We counted, bagged and distributed to various area groups, including the Elsie Baby Pantry, area Food Banks, Shiawassee Catholic Charities, Jackson Christmas Child Project and more. Also, quilts were donated to the following organizations: Homeless Angels, Shiawassee Council on Aging, Respite Volunteers of Shiawassee and Voices for Children Organization. (Thank you Pat Elliott for delivering them!). And finally, several quilts have been given as comfort quilts.

With all these donations, we have depleted our supply of quilts. Come join us on Thursdays from 9 to noon and do a little sewing.

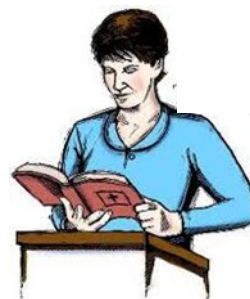
