We are now over halfway through the beautiful month of May. The month of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The flowers are blooming and the weather seems to finally be taking a step up. It has been an odd spring, most definitely, up until this point. It sometimes seemed that we would never have consistently warm weather and yet here we are. This month also there are congratulations are in order to all those young souls who have received our Blessed Lord in the Eucharist for the first time, may God bless you!

As it is the month of Mary, we should reexamine our own devotion to the Mother of our Savior. I must say that I find it saddening when I am speaking to someone and they know so little about Mary, or how often I have had a child in confession tell me they couldn't say the hail Mary's for penance they received because they didn't know how. The family is the first school, the first place where a child learns and develops habits - we learn either to pray or learn to not pray.
