ATTENTION ALL WOMEN OF HOLY FAMILY AND ST. ISIDORE

This is your personal invitation to participate in a small group retreat, "33 Days to Morning Glory", which will lead you to consecrating yourself to Jesus through Mary.

People's lives today are often busy and challenging. This preparation of consecration is a quick (we meet only 6 times) and it is a easy way to withdraw from the demands of daily life and enter into a peaceful interior reflection on your relationship with Christ in the context of Marian devotion. Mary leads us to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The end result is that, by learning to entrust ourselves to the Mother of Our Lord, we can discover a transforming trust in Jesus himself.

Why consecrate yourself? It is a gift from Jesus directly to all of us, from the cross, of his own mother as our mother. John 19:26-27 A consecration says "yes" to Jesus' invitation from the cross and "thank you". As we receive her and her love it will allow her to form us in holiness. It prepares us for the presence of God so that He feels welcome in our hearts, lives, families, parishes, businesses, and communities. The fulfillment and purpose of our consecration to the Lord is to glorify God, that is, to allow God to be lived out from us and expressed through us. The act of consecration through Mary "establishes a relationship of love with her in which we dedicate to her all that we have and are," says St. John Paul II. "The surest, easiest, shortest, and the most perfect means to becoming a saint, is a total consecration to Jesus through Mary." - St. Louis de Montfort




