

Notes from Fr. Anthony



"The Rosary is a powerful weapon to put the demons to flight and to keep oneself from sin...If you desire peace in your hearts, in your homes, and in your country, assemble each evening to recite the Rosary. Let not even one day pass without saying it, no matter how burdened you may be with many cares and labors." - Pope Pius XI

This week we are going to take a little break from our journey through the heresies and take a quick stop at one of the most beloved and common Catholic devotions - the Rosary. As we are still in the month of the rosary, we should take a moment to learn a little more about it. First, we will deal with one of the more common objections to the Hail Mary and the Biblical ignorance of those who object to it by saying that the Hail Mary is "unbiblical". Where is the Hail Mary found in the Bible. The majority of it is found hiding in plain sight at the beginning of the Gospel of Luke and the words are almost entirely those of the Archangel Gabriel himself and Elizabeth, the mother of St. John the Baptist who was the forerunner of Christ, the last of the Old Testament prophets and the first one to recognize Christ as the Savior and Messiah. And so we begin:

- 1. Hail Mary, full of Grace Luke 1:28 (Hail, full of Grace)
- 2. The Lord is with You Luke 1:28 (The Lord is with you)
- <u>3. Blessed are you among Women</u> Luke 1:41 (Blessed are you among women)
- 4. And Blessed is the fruit of thy womb Jesus Luke 1:42 (and blessed is the fruit of your womb)
- <u>5. Holy Mary, Mother of God</u> Luke 1:43 (And why is this granted me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?)
- 6. Pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death James 5:16 (Therefore confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man has great power in its effects) Acts 2:13-14 (When they entered the city they went to the upper room where they were staying, Peter and John and James and Andrew, Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew, James son of Alphaeus, Simon the Zealot, and Judas son of James. All these devoted themselves with one accord to prayer, together with some women, and Mary the mother of Jesus)

So let us take this gift to heart and ensure that the rosary is a constant daily prayer for us and our families. If we desire peace and goodness in our homes, families, or country, it will not come without the Rosarv. The Rosarv is an excellent way of worshipping the Holy and Divine Trinity which brought us into being and offers us salvation out of an immensity of love and it is a prayer honoring the Blessed Virgin, the Mother of Christ, whose love for God is beyond telling and who is also our Mother and the Mother of the Church. It is always a sad thing to hear from young children that they do not know the rosary or the Hail Mary. Would we send them out into the snow without a hat and gloves? Would we let them walk by the road on their own? Would we allow them to go alone into a bad neighborhood? Obviously not. We love them and are concerned for them and we are aware of the great dangers out in the world; we do all we can to protect them and show them safe paths to travel. Should we not ensure that they are on spiritually safe paths first? Should we send them out into the world spiritually unarmed or unprepared? Is family prayer one of the first things of importance or is it an afterthought? Do we strive to give our Lord quality time, or do we give Him leftovers?

The Rosary is an easy prayer that we can say together. It is easy for the young and old, the highly educated or the more simple. It is a prayer for all of us.

"If you say the Rosary faithfully until death, I do assure you that, in spite of the gravity of your sins you shall receive a never-fading crown of glory. Even if you are on the brink of damnation, even if you have one foot in hell, even if you have sold your soul to the devil as sorcerers do who practice black magic, and even if you are a heretic as obstinate as a devil, sooner or later you will be converted and will amend your life and will save your soul, if— and mark well what I say—if you say the Holy Rosary devoutly every day until death for the purpose of knowing the truth and obtaining contrition and pardon for your sins."
