Our Father.....

After the Our Father the lintels are marked with the chalk, example:

20 + C + M + B + 24.

The initials, C - M - B are for the names of the three kings — Casper, Melchior and Balthasar. These initials are a double acronym and also stand for the Latin phrase "Christus mansionem benedicat" which means "Christ bless this house".
